Two new Omaha premieres, three novel adaptations and one frighteningly hilarious Hollywood hybrid are coming soon to Film Streams' Ruth Sokolof Theater.

Omaha, Nebraska (6/27/11) – Breathtaking works of animation, outstanding adaptations of literary classics, and the most delightful comedy of horrors you're likely to see—this summer, Film Streams' ongoing Forever Young Family & Children's Series covers a lot of ground. The series will feature two new Omaha premieres: the visually stunning, hand-painted feature *MIA AND THE MIGOO* (from the distributors of last year's Oscar-nominated *THE SECRET OF KELLS*) and the animated shorts program *A WORLD OF ANIMATION FROM CHILDREN'S FILM FESTIVAL SEATTLE 2011*.

The new season also brings three outstanding live-action films with novel origins: Robert Mulligan's *TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD*, Disney's *TREASURE ISLAND*, and the Academy Award-nominated 1994 version of *LITTLE WOMEN*.

The summer series rounds the corner into October with the perfect pre-Halloween family outing, the 1948 genre-bending farce, *ABBOTT AND COSTELLO MEET FRANKENSTEIN*. See below for more about the films in this series.
