

La Vie en Rose, the encore

A day after her concert at the Holland Performing Arts Center, singer Jil Aigrot (“the voice of Edith Piaf”) will appear at Film Streams’ Ruth Sokolof Theater for a special screening of LA VIE EN ROSE.

OMAHA (3/9/11) – On Sunday, March 20 at 2 p.m., Film Streams and Omaha Performing Arts will present a special screening of the 2007 Academy Award-winning film LA VIE EN ROSE with a post-show conversation featuring “the voice of Edith Piaf,” singer Jil Aigrot.

The Sunday matinee screening will take place the day after Aigrot’s concert performance at the Holland Performing Arts Center, part of the Omaha Performing Arts Classical Now Series, sponsored by Omaha Steaks.

While LA VIE EN ROSE brought an Oscar to actress Marion Cotillard for her portrayal of the legendary French songstress, it was Aigrot who provided the stunning voice of Edith Piaf for the film.

LA VIE EN ROSE holds a special significance for Film Streams, as it was the initial first-run premiere to show at the nonprofit’s Ruth Sokolof Theater when it opened in July 2007.

The special screening is part of Film Streams’ Community Development Program, which facilitates partnerships with other nonprofits and community groups on film-related events that speak to their missions and programming.

Tickets for the LA VIE EN ROSE screening with Jil Aigrot are \$9 for adults, \$7 for seniors, students, teachers and military, and \$4.50 for Film Streams Members. The \$7 discount price will also be available to those presenting a ticket stub from the prior evening’s Jil Aigrot concert.
