The Irish countryside provides the setting for this gorgeously shot, lovingly told fable about a 10-year-old girl who discovers the remarkable secret of her family's past.



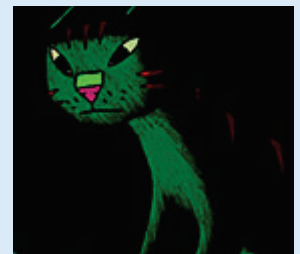
